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## CONFERENCE REPORT

## INTERCHANGE OF EXPERIENCE IN ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING

March 1-2, 1977, the 3rd International Seminar on Wastewater Treatment and Disposal of Industrial Solid Wastes was held at the Wrocław Technical University, promoted by:

- the Polish Society of Sanitary Engineers and Technicians (stands for PZiTS), Poland,

- the Institut für Siedlungswasserbau und Wassergütewirtschaft, Stuttgart University, FRG, and,

- the Institute of Environmental Protection Engineering, Wrocław Technical University, Poland.

24 invited papers were brought to discussion, 8 of them held by the research workers of the Stuttgart University, 16 by Polish authors.

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O. TABASARAN: Treatment of wastewater generated during the washing of pyrolysis-exhaust-gases,

A. KOWAL: Water reclamation for industrial purposes,

B. KOZIOROWSKI and A. OLESZCZYK: Technological characteristics of industrial sludges,

B. KOZIOROWSKI and A. OLESZCZYK: Properties of aerated lagoon sludge,

M. FERBER: Controlled tipping of refuse and special types of wastes,

H. SZCZEŚNIAK: Re-use of some mineral residues,

W. SCHENKEL: Hazardous industrial wastes,

P. ŻURAWSKI: On the possible utilization of flue-ashes generated by power-plants.

All the reports are published in the following two Conference Books: Scientific Papers of the Institute of Environment Protection Engineering of Wrocław Technical University, No 32, Conference No 5 (in Polish) and No 42, Conference No 9 (in German as a special issue of the "Stuttgarter Berichte zur Abfallwirtschaft").

The 350 participants of the Seminar represented 6 European Countries (A, B, ČS, D, H and PL), as compared with the 200 representatives at the 1<sup>st</sup> Seminar held at Cracow (Poland) 1973, and the 80 at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Seminar held at Stuttgart 1975, who came from 3 countries.

Each session was followed by discussions. The address of Professor Zygmunt Rudolf, Senior and Honorary Member of PZiTS and Fellow of the British Royal Society of Hygiene has brought particular attention.

The discussions have proved that the pollution control problems call for a wide international cooperation and information exchange. Such a cooperation is accomplished following the agreement between the PZiTS and the University of Stuttgart.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> days, the Speakers and invited Professors discussed in the health resort of Szklarska Poreba the teaching and education programmes of undergraduate, graduate and advanced post-graduate studies. Some preliminary agreements were made for the 4<sup>th</sup> Seminar which is planned to be held at the Stuttgart University in March, 1979.
